2006	Multi	<i>E. coli</i> O157:H7	Baby spinach	205	Outbreak strain found in grassfed beef cattle feces and organically grown baby spinach
2006	CA	<i>E. coli</i> O157:H7	Raw milk/raw colostrum	6	Non-outbreak strain of <i>E. coli</i> O157:H7 found in grassfed, organic heifers
2007	WA	<i>Campylobacter</i>	Raw milk	5	Outbreak strain found in grassfed milk
2007	CA	<i>Campylobacter</i>	Raw milk/raw colostrum	11	Outbreak strain found in grassfed, organic cow feces
2007	CA	<i>Listeria</i>	Raw cream	No illnesses reported	Listeria found in grassfed, organic cream during routine testing
2008	CA	<i>Campylobacter</i>	Raw cream	No illnesses reported	Campylobacter found in grassfed, organic cream during routine testing
2009	CO	<i>Campylobacter</i>	Raw milk	81	PCR positive test for Campylobacter in grassfed raw milk
